Poster preparation guidelines

1. The available dimensions for placing the poster are wide=1.20m, height = 1.80m.
2. The title of your paper should appear on top in capital letters with a size greater than 2.5 cm. Authors and their respective affiliations should be located below the title.
3. The flow of the poster must be from top left to the bottom right. Use arrows to guide the audience along the poster. Use pictures, diagrams, figures rather than plain text wherever possible.
4. The font size should not be less than 9 mm. Use combinations of colors to highlight important details of their work. It is recommended to use the sans-serif, Helvetica or CMS fonts which are easy to read.
5. Try to make your poster as self-explanatory as possible and feel free to use additional support material such as prototypes, demos, and / or audiovisual material (preferably battery operated).
6. Prepare a 5 to 7 minutes presentation that the authors should repeat for interested participants gathered around the poster during the poster session.
7. Your poster should include the key points of your research. Avoid including excessive working details. Authors could discuss the details after the short presentation.
8. Authors should place the poster at least 30 minutes before the poster session. Authors must remove their posters immediately after the end of the session.
